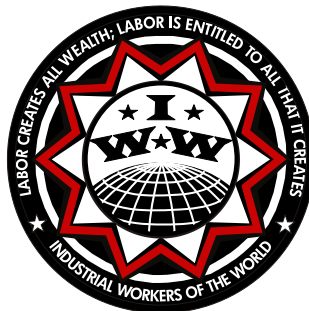


What will it mean to *“abolish the wage system”* ???
